Devon Nicole's House has made some serious strides in the last 6 months. From November to February we had 7different fundraising events that supporters of DNH put together. (Toys and Pampered Chef, Basket Bingo, Candle Lite Party, Mall of NH Evening of Giving, Luisa's Christmas Party, Stampin' Up, and finally the Valentines Dinner!) We extend our heart felt thanks to all those that helped!! The biggest of these was the 2nd Annual Valentines Cruise. It was a HUGE success thanks to a lot of work from the DNH Board, and a very generous check presented by the Founders of Jason's Place. The Dinner raised over \$72,000! We send out an especially big Thank You to all that attended and helped to make this years Cruise even better than last years! We have some exciting changes for next years Valentines Dinner.. stay tuned!

The other BIG news is that we are getting a lot closer to being able to formally announce the approximate opening date and location of Devon Nicole's House hopefully at the Golf Tournament! A group interested in helping to create a home for Devon Nicole's House approached us in February with a tentative site. As soon as it is official we hope to make a formal announcement to the press and will post the details on our web site. (We are hoping to get the news out prior to the Golf Tournament in June!) The entire DNH Board has been both over-whelmed and consumed by the offer. There are several obstacles that we face in the immediate future; the most significant is scaling our focus and energies to the operational side of the house. Ideally we would like to have 2 years of funding in the bank before opening our doors for business. Right now we are about \$75,000 short. We are also still trying to figure out where the money will come from for the proposed renovations for the home.

We are finding that fund-raising and development is a full time job. The Board has approved the hiring of a full or part-time

professional Fund-raiser/Developer. We've already started to interview some people through friends of DNH. A job description will be posted on the website by the time this newsletter reaches you.

We will also need to hire a General Manager or Director to run the day-to-day operations of Devon Nicole's House. We expect this position to be the most critical issue that our board will face in next few months. This person will be the face and voice to the hundreds of families that will stay at DNH. A description for this job should also be up on the website by the end of May.

The next six months will bring a lot of changes... We are adding a second major fund-raising event to our annual schedule. We hope that the Golf Tournament will be a big hit and really get our name and mission out there. We are confident that there are people that have not heard about what we are trying to do that will ultimately play a major role in helping us build the dream of Devon Nicole's House. 
